Royal Gurkhas Institute of Technology ("RGIT") was surprised and disappointed to be notified by ASQA on 31<sup>st</sup> of May 2019 of its decision to not renew our registration as a RTO, effective 5<sup>th</sup> of July 2019. RGIT maintains it meets its legal obligations and it is a quality vocational training provider and RTO.

RGIT will apply to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal for review of ASQA's decision and to stay its operation pending the hearing and determination of its review application. RGIT has obtained legal advice and it strongly believes it is compliant with its legal and other obligations. It looks forward to the opportunity to demonstrate it is not only compliant but that it delivers quality training across the wide range of courses it delivers and which it has successfully delivered to numerous students over many years.

RGIT remains registered. We are able to conduct teaching and training as usual and we will continue with our current timetable for all our students. Our immediate focus is to achieve a positive outcome as soon as possible which will be in the best interests of our students and staff.
